Our teachers have planned many engaging and meaningful learning experiences for our students this term. We will be sharing with you updates of our Term 4 programmes and we look forward to another term of impactful school activities with your child/ward.

HOME-SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP

1. Term 4 School Calendar

2. P1 Orientation Day

Our P1 Orientation Day will be held in the afternoon of 14 November to welcome the P1 cohort for 2026. The students will be meeting their teachers and new friends while exploring their future classrooms through fun activities.

3. Prize Presentation Day cum P6 Graduation Day

To celebrate the efforts and achievements of our students and staff, we will be having our Prize Presentation Day cum P6 Graduation Day on 21 November. The theme for this year is "Shining with PRIDE". Only P3 to P5 prize recipients and all P6 students will attend the ceremony. Students are to report in their full school uniform. Invitation letters will be issued to the parents of the prize recipients at a later date.

4. Parent Support Group (PSG) Meeting

Our school will be holding our PSG Meeting on 21 November afternoon. We will be celebrating the efforts and active involvement of members for this year. PSG EXCO will be organising bonding activities for members. This would be a great opportunity for parent volunteers to get to know one another. 5. Eat with Your Family Day (EWYFD)

EWYFD is a nation-wide initiative to encourage Singaporeans to consciously set aside time on that day to be with their families. Our school's General Office will close at 4.30 pm on 21 November, so that our staff too can leave work earlier to enjoy a meal with their family.

STUDENT WELL-BEING AND DEVELOPMENT

6. Students' Achievements

Our students have participated and performed well in various competitions. We would like to commend and congratulate the students. Their achievements are listed in Annex B.

7. Leading Self

To support our students in leading themselves, we would like to remind them and seek your partnership too in the following matters:

a) Punctuality and Attendance

Regular school attendance is essential for our students to learn effectively. We urge parents and guardians to work closely with the school to ensure your child/ward attends school regularly. Any absence from school should be covered by a medical certificate or proof of Ag+. A signed letter from the parent/guardian will be taken into consideration on a case-by-case basis. Please note that the number of signed letters from parent/guardian should not exceed ten per year.

Please also note that absence from school due to private vacation is considered "absent without valid reason". We would like to remind parents not to book any holidays during the school term, especially for the P6 students after their PSLE. The school has planned programmes for the P6 students after their PSLE. Absence without valid reason is considered a school offence.

CURRICULUM MATTERS

8. Academic Support

Academic support lessons and programmes will carry on as per normal from Term 4 Week 1 or 2. Students would have received a consent form if they were selected.

9. P6 Study Break

There is a study break for P6 students from 22 to 24 September. To provide support for our P6 students, the school has planned for either online Microsoft Teams revision or face-to-face revision in school during the study break on 22 and 23 Sep. The school would send more information to parents of P6 students at a later date.

10. Assessment

a) Holistic Assessment (HA)

Parents would be given a learning progress report at the end of Term 4 to inform them of the level of acquisition of skills of their child in the different subjects.

b) P3 to P5 End-of-Year Examinations (EYE)

There would be End-of-Year Examinations for P3 to P5 students. The percentage weightage for EYE is 60% for P5 students and 70% for P3 and P4 students. To prepare for the examinations, we urge parents to remind your children to be consistent and regular in revising their schoolwork. Please refer to **Annex C** for details.

c) Access Arrangement (AA) for P3 to P5 End-of-Year Examinations (EYE)

Students with diagnosed learning needs may receive AA during examinations. If your child has been recommended to receive AA and you have not notified the school, please do so latest by 15 September via your child's Form Teachers. A copy of psychological/professional medical report that clearly states the specific learning needs/ medical conditions and the recommended access arrangement is required.

d) Absence for P3 to P5 End-of-Year Examinations (EYE)

If your child is absent for the oral examination, he/she will be able to do a make-up examination on another day arranged by the school. We would like to inform parents/guardians that the <u>make-up session will only be conducted for oral examination</u>. Do note that there is <u>no make-up for all written papers</u>. This is in line with the examination practice for national examinations.

If your child is absent for any of the written papers during the EYE, the teacher would allow your child to attempt the paper as a practice exercise at a later date. The paper would be marked to enable your child to learn and gauge his/her performance. However, the marks would not be recorded.

Students who are absent on the exam day(s) must produce a Medical Certificate from a licensed medical officer, proof of Ag+ or have other valid reasons (such as bereavement of family members) for their absence. Their marks would then be computed based on this consideration. Students who are absent from examinations without a valid reason would be marked as being absent without valid reason. No marks would be awarded for the paper that they have missed.

e) Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE)

Our P6 students would be sitting for the PSLE Listening Comprehension Examinations on 16 September and written examinations from 25 September to 1 October. The following groups of students would have their Home-based Learning (HBL) on the dates listed below. They do not come to school.

- P5 students on 25 September.
- P4 students on 26 September
- P3 students on 29 September

All P6 students would have received their PSLE examination schedule which was given together with their entry proof. A copy of the examination timetable can be found in **Annex D**.
